Pat will forward the information to the committee, so that the committee can evaluate how many of the preceptors are actually precepting students/experienced providers.

There was a question about the fees charged for consolidated testing in our region, and how the new method of testing will impact the cost to the Council for running test sites. Pat said that was a BOD decision and will have to be addressed to the BOD.

OEMS will be hosting webinars outlining the new EMS Training Fund Program All training funds will be in one program after July 2008. Everyone is encouraged to attend one of these training.
